When should I apply?

Keep in mind that our program is not an emergency service. It is a lengthy process due to the nature of the work, but well worth the wait. We work year-round and the sooner you apply, the sooner you will start saving!

Champlain Valley Weatherization Service is a program of the Champlain Valley Office of Economic Opportunity (CVOEO), a nonprofit agency that bridges gaps and builds futures. Please call or visit your local community action office (in Burlington, Middlebury and St. Albans) to learn about additional programs from which you may benefit.

Who is CVOEO?

Champlain Valley Weatherization Service is a **free** service for income eligible households. You can apply whether you own your home or rent. An Energy Efficiency Coach will meet with you to review the process and begin assessing your home and energy usage. Next an energy auditor will conduct a complete evaluation. Then our professional crews install the most cost-effective, energy efficient improvements based on the results of the audit. These may include insulation and air sealing to help make your home more energy efficient, safer, and more comfortable year round.

The Steps

1 APPLICATION

The first step is to complete the enclosed application and return it to us. Please understand that the process is lengthy. If you need help completing your application, please contact us at:

2 ENERGY EFFICIENCY COACH

After we have determined your eligibility, an energy efficiency coach will visit to go over the weatherization process and assess your home for electrical efficiency upgrades.

3 ENERGY AUDIT

Next an energy auditor will conduct a site visit, gather energy performance information and determine the most cost-effective energy improvements. If you rent, the auditor will visit your home twice, first to do a walk through with the property owner and second to perform an in-depth energy performance evaluation.

4 THE WORK

Our professional crews will then arrive to install the efficiency measures recommended by our energy auditor. The work usually takes 2-4 days.

Income Guidelines

Guidelines are for gross income. Self-employed applicants should use net business income. Recipients of Fuel Assistance and Emergency Fuel Assistance in the past twelve months may automatically be eligible for services.
