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Meeting called to order by Chair Susan Klaiber at 6:02pm

**Visitors Business:** None.

**Discussion of DRB Decision:** Received the final DRB decision. Does not appear to be any major changes between draft and final. S. Klaiber reached out to GVV and they stated they were ready to proceed whenever we were. T. Estey reached out to our wastewater consultant about adding a bathroom to the existing approved wastewater design and the consultant in turn reached out to the state to ask some questions. Response pending but the consultant is pretty sure we will have to apply for an amendment. The original wastewater permit was approved for 50 people but regulations have since been amended to allow for 60 with the same system, so in theory the extra 10 can be attributed to the fire station bathroom. S. Klaiber also spoke with Rebecca Elder about what is needed for a “final Mylar.” It must show an accurate septic design which we will not have until we hear back from the State. Our WW consultant may be willing to produce the “Mylar” once all information is known.

**Renewed Charge to Committee:** S. Klaiber requested a few minutes at the April 4 Selectboard meeting to discuss progress so far, an overall work plan, a possible review of the committee’s charge, and other related matters.

**ARPA Proposals:** Continued conversation around testing the water at schoolhouse without the existing faucet to see if the whole system needs to be replaced or just a faucet. L. McCarthy agreed to attempt to replace the faucet and order a water testing kit from the Department of Health to test the water as soon as it is turned back on.

**Minutes:** Review and discussion of 2/27 minutes

**Motion:** T. Estey made a motion to approve the 2/27 minutes. A Quittner seconded.
