Starksboro Selectboard Meeting Minutes of 1/18/22 Unapproved

Board members present: Nancy Boss, Eric Cota, Koran Cousino, John Painter, Carin McCarthy **Others present:** Rebecca Elder, Robert Turner, Mark Kingsley, Anne Sasso

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Koran Cousino at the Town Clerk's office and via Zoom.

Changes or Additions - none Visitor's Business – none

Budget discussion

Discussion included whether to propose to establish a fund for major community improvements. The board decided to hold this discussion for the next budget year. In a normal year, this could be something proposed from the floor at town meeting for discussion. However, because this year will be an Australian ball to vote (due to COVID precautions) there will not be an opportunity for such discussion.

- During the fundraising for the community pavilion project, folks asked about Jerusalem school project and how that would be funded as well. Need to look at community priorities and where/when to deploy funds.
- Board talked about maintenance needed at Jerusalem schoolhouse and upgrades that are needed after the roof work is complete in the spring.
- IT budget shift one laptop purchase to current year from surplus funds and likely won't need to purchase one next year
- Discussion of surplus uses: Paying down debt, level fund budget, emergency reserve, paving reserve. There are many unknowns that are beyond our control. The board wants to make investments in the community and also keep tax increases to a minimum when possible.
- Town administrator position the board would like to explore this further for the next year, but is not prepared to add that to the budget for now. Increase in hours for various staff was anticipated and may help cover the gap for now.
- Major Maintenance Fund Again the board wants to research this and plan well ahead of the budget season.

The board elected to use \$90K of FY21 surplus to offset anticipated budget growth from 21/22 to 22/23. The proposed budget remains flat at \$707,768. The remainder will go to the Emergency reserve fund and paving reserve fund, split 60/40.
