The meeting was called to order at 4:30 pm at the Starksboro town office. The purpose of the meeting was to conduct a site visit of the Class 4 roads proposed to be reclassified to trails.

The Selectboard drove to Mason Hill South, parked by the cemetery and continued on foot. The road becomes impassable to vehicles within ¼ mile. The road appears to be a creek bed. The Board then drove to Mason Hill North and drove as far as possible before the road became impassable. P. Marsh had previously walked the length of the road and provided pictures.

After that, the Board went to Brown Hill East and drove through to Brown Hill West. It was obvious that most vehicles would not have been able to use the road. We noted that the road is not in the town right of way in one section. The entrance to Perry Sweet Road could not be reached in a vehicle.

The Selectboard will discuss a possible plan to change the road status at the September 19<sup>th</sup> meeting.
