The meeting was called to order by Chair Susan Klaiber at 6:10 p.m.

Visitors Business: None

Kick-Off Discussion: D. Viehmann and C. Nguyen of GVV Architects lead a discussion on the basic schedule of the project, the overall meeting schedule, and pointed out structural issues that need to be considered. They also asked many questions of the committee ranging from various ages of portions of the Schoolhouse to basic needs of the Fire Department, and possible future uses of the facility.

Community Survey Revisions and Logistics: The draft community survey was reviewed and discussed. A couple of minor revisions were discussed and the committee agreed on the dates of two “listening sessions” to be included in the survey. It is the intent of the committee to send the survey out in the first week of July. S. Klaiber and M. Nedzinski offered to coordinate with Arc & Arrow to make the revisions and get the survey finalized.

Motion made by G. Orvis to have S. Klaiber and M. Nedzinski coordinate with Arc & Arrow to make minor revisions and finalize the survey. Seconded by T. Estey.

Vote: All in favor.

Discussion of Committee member replacement: An original member of the JCCC resigned and the Select Board accepted the resignation, leaving the Committee with 6 members. The Committee discussed the possible need for a seventh member and various individuals were discussed. T. Estey offered to reach out to the Select Board and the individuals mentioned to gauge their interest and will report back to the Committee.

Motion: L. McCarthy made a motion to adjourn, T. Estey seconded.

Vote: All in favor
